REMINDER WHILE ATTENDING Masking is especially important at this time and all are strongly encouraged to do so. Please retain your mask while in the communion line, removing it at the chalice, and remember to keep distance while in the line.

Please do not take a place directly behind or in front of others! Keep an empty pew in between you and others when possible. Alternate between the center and the outer edges of the pews when consecutive pews are occupied.

Receiving Communion: Please tilt your head back and open your mouth wide, so that clergy can tip the spoon directly into your mouth without making physical contact.

Narthex Clustering: Please do not cluster in the narthex to socialize at the conclusion of services. Take your holy bread (if at a Liturgy) and proceed immediately and directly outside. There you may talk and visit with others
